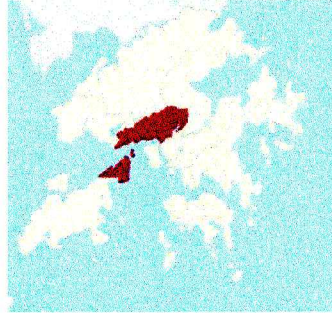


# Tsuen Wan Attractions

Tsuen Wan is a town in the western New Territories of Hong Kong along the coast line. It is a gorgeous place with many historical, natural and recreational attractions to visit.



## Natural Attractions

### Tai Mo Shan Country Park

Tai Mo Shan Country Park is located in northern Tsuen Wan. You can take the minibus to there. You can go to the visitor centre to learn about more of Tai Mo Shan. You can also see a stunning sunset there!



## Historical attractions

### Sam Tung Uk Museum

Sam Tung Uk Museum is located in Luk Yeung Sun Cheun. You can walk there from Tsuen Wan Station in 4 minutes. It is a 200-years-old HaKka walled village. You can learn how people lived in the past.



## Recreational Attractions

### Tsuen Wan Park

Tsuen Wan Park is opposite to Tsuen Wan West Station. You can get there by bus 234A at Tsuen Wan Station for 6 minutes. You may go cycling and jogging at the promenade. There is also a playground to let children play for a whole day.

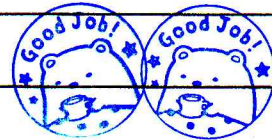

around the reservoir. It is a good place to take a photo.

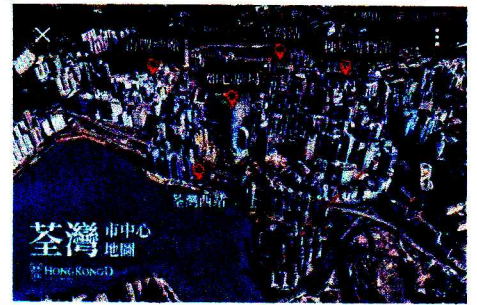
Moreover, you can fly kites and have a barbecue at the barbecue zone.

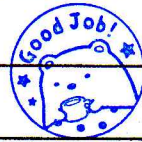

## Citygate Outlets

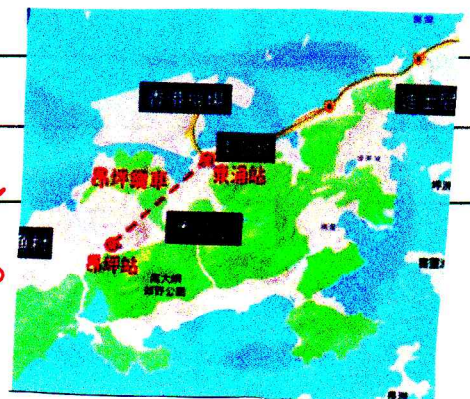

Tsuen Wan is located in the western New Territories along the coast. It has lots of shopping malls and streets, but it's also a place of history and culture.

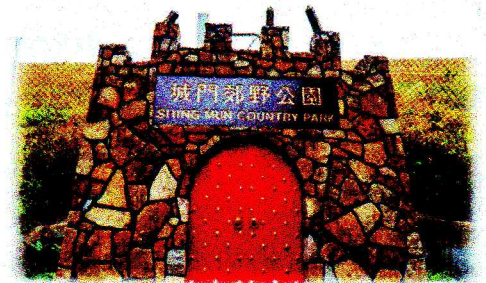
Historical Attraction – Sam Tung Uk Museum

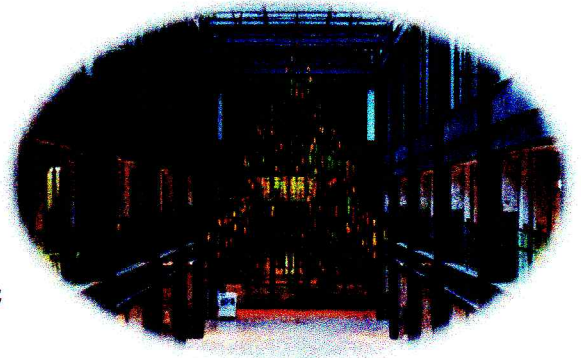
Natural Attraction – Shing Mun Country Park
