As primary school students, how can we protect endangered animals?

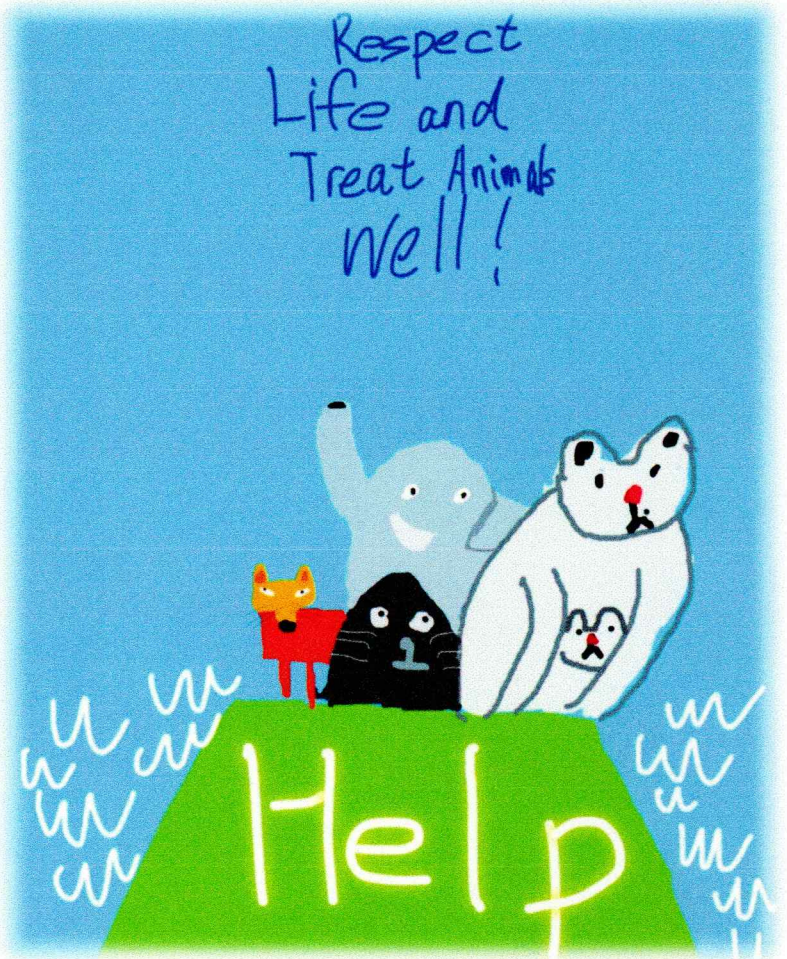
