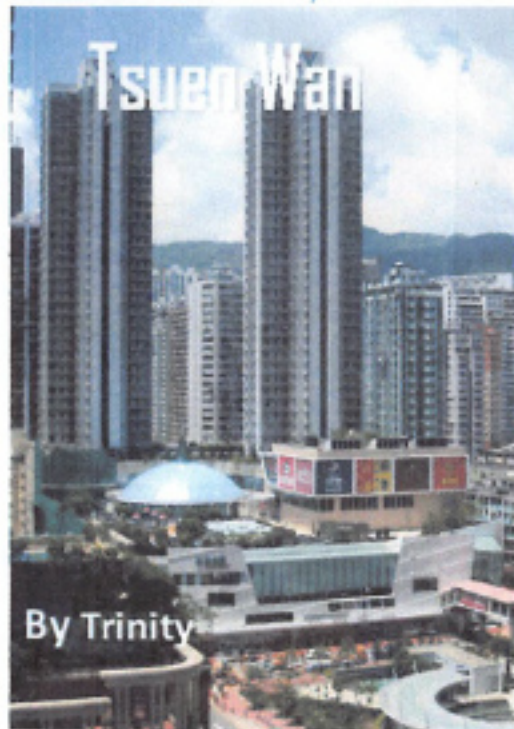
Recreational Attraction

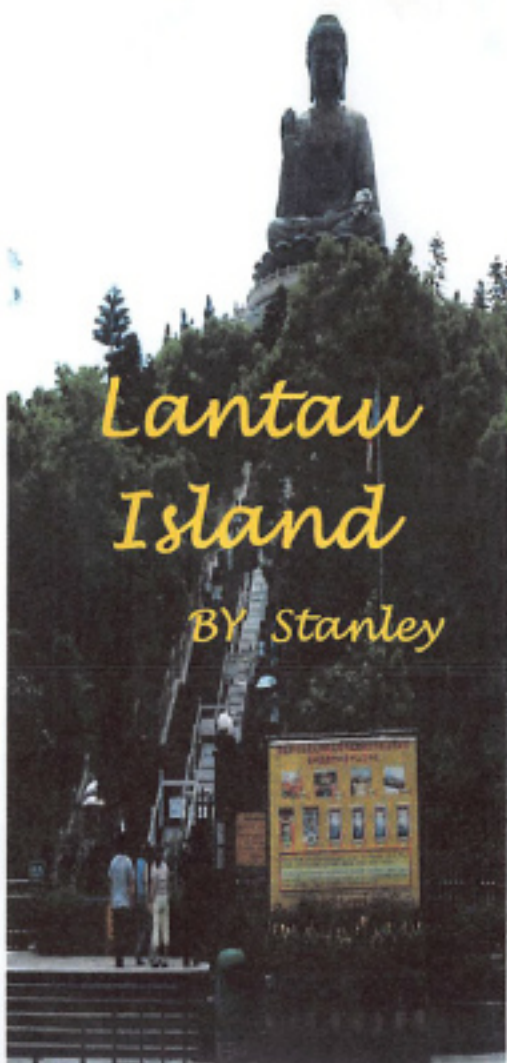

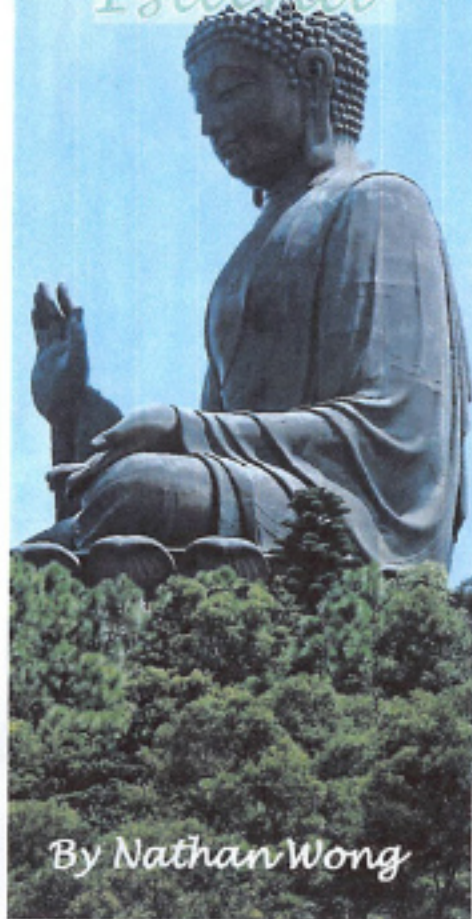

Lantau Peak (Nature attraction)

Lantau Peak is the second highest peak in Hong Kong and the highest point on Lantau Island, with a height of 934 metres (3064 ft) above sea level. Lantau Peak is one of the most popular hiking spots in Hong Kong and can be reached by the Lantau

Trail. At the foot of Lantau Peak, a tourist spot called the Wisdom Path can be found.

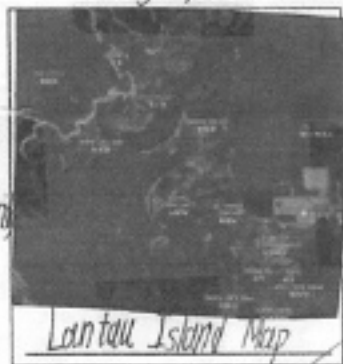

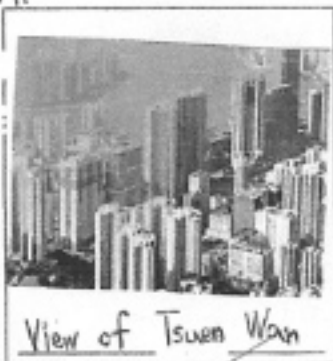

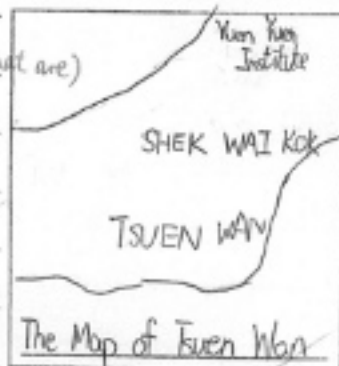
